

# EMERGENCY SHELTERS IN LAUSANNE

## MUNICIPAL DECISIONS effective as of 1<sup>st</sup> February 2016

### RESERVATIONS AND DEADLINES

People wishing to be accommodated in one of the emergency shelters of the City of Lausanne have to enquire at the Reservations Office. The staff of the Reservations Office allocates reservations according to the availabilities; users can specify a preference but cannot choose where they want to sleep.

The emergency shelters of the City of Lausanne are not intended for people under an asylum procedure or receiving the cantonal emergency aid.

To obtain a reservation at the Reservations Office the user has to give a name, a first name, his date of birth, his nationality and a photo is taken. All data are treated in confidence.

The reservations are allocated as follows:

Status	Situation of the user	Length of stay	Reservation deadline
G1	Resident of Lausanne for more than a year, of Swiss nationality or with valid residence permit	14 nights, renewable	Up to 15 days in advance
G2	Elderly or sick person, woman, child accompanied by a parent	14 nights, renewable over 3 years (up to 12 months in total)	Up to 15 days in advance
G2T	Person of Swiss nationality or with valid residence permit with an employment contract and an actual work	14 nights, renewable for up to 3 months	Up to 15 days in advance
G3	Others	7 nights in winter, 2 nights in summer, renewable if possible	Up to 7 days in advance

As a consequence of these new modalities, the status of a number of users will be changed (G1, G2, G3).

### PRICE

Price for a night: CHF 5.- per person. Free for children below 10 years. This price includes a light meal in the evening, a bed for the night, a breakfast in the morning and the opportunity to take a shower.

### EMERGENCIES

The emergency shelters will no longer have beds to allocate in the evening. Users will have to possess a reservation card to be admitted in the shelters. Only emergencies will be accommodated in the evening without reservation (notably the newcomers and the people brought by Police or EMUS).

### PENALTIES

- 7 nights penalty after 2 non-excused absences.
- 7 nights penalty in case of transmission of a reservation card to another user or use of the card of another user.
- 30 nights penalty in case of use of several identities at the Reservations Office.
- Minimum 7 nights penalty in case of failure to respect the shelter rules.
- Definitive exclusion from all the emergency shelters in case of commitment of a crime or offence in a shelter.
